#### Homily Message:

The Mass is the place where all of us can offer everything we have to God without shame. He feeds us with his real Body and Blood. It's not a symbol.

#### Grace to pray for this week:

To come to Mass ready to offer my life and receive the total life of Jesus Christ.

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace to you and welcome to Sacred Heart Parish. If you come to us as a guest please know how honored we are by your presence. Each person here matters!

This weekend Fr. Scott & I are celebrating the anniversaries of our ordination: 1 year for him and...17 for me. I speak confidently for both of us when I say that we love being priests. Neither of us are worthy of serving the Church in this way but this just proves that God's grace has no limit!

At the heart of the priesthood is the celebration of the Eucharist (the Mass). Catholicism is unique among Christian traditions in that our worship flows from a direct commandment of Jesus: "Do THIS in memory of me." At the Mass the priest, standing in the person of Jesus, makes present the sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary. No form of worship can surpass the complete offering that Jesus made to the Father on our behalf. We get to encounter this every day in our parish if we choose!

Think about it - if the Eucharist is *literally* the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus - what kind of power is available to us? What if we were open to its power to heal, nourish, and transform? We could not possibly remain the same people. That's why we celebrate *Corpus Christi* this weekend.

Please pray for all priests and for more priests. Thank you for supporting us in this vocation. You and your spiritual growth mean everything to us. We love you.

Our annual *Corpus Christi* procession begins after the 11:30 am Mass this weekend at St. Mary's. Please join us, especially if you've never experienced this before. You'll find a beauty and power to walking with the Lord and one another.

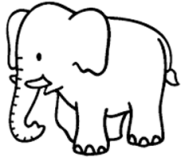
