The Baptism of the Lord

Dear Friends,

Peace to you and welcome to Sacred Heart Parish. We have many guests enter our doors. If you are visiting this weekend, we extend to you a warm welcome.

In times past, the end of the Christmas Season was marked 40 days after Christmas on February 2nd, the Presentation of Jesus in the temple. In our day and age we move into Ordinary Time after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which we celebrate this weekend.

Jesus' baptism is what we call a "theophany", or a moment when we get a glimpse of his divinity. Jesus was baptized not because he needed sin to be removed (he is sinless) but to make all the waters on the earth fitting for baptism and to lead the way he wants us to go.

The Catechism of the Church says: "Jesus' gesture [of submitting to baptism] is a manifestation of self-emptying. The Spirit who had hovered over the waters of the first creation descended then on the Christ as a prelude to the new creation, and the Father revealed Jesus as 'his beloved Son'" (CCC 1224).

Most of us don't remember our baptism and consequently we miss out on quite a bit of its transformative power. I love talking with people who were baptized from their teen years and older. They often speak with great joy (and tears) of that moment. The experience is similar to that of Jesus in that they "hear" the voice of the Father saying beautiful words of love to them.

If you've never been baptized we'd love to walk with you toward receiving this gift. If you have been baptized say thank you to your parents and godparents even if they have died. They gave you the most important gift of becoming a son or daughter of God.

God love you!

El bautismo del señor

Queridos amigos,

Paz para ustedes y bienvenidos a la Parroquia del Sagrado Corazón. Tenemos muchos invitados entrando por nuestras puertas. Si está de visita este fin de semana, te damos una cálida bienvenida.

En tiempos pasados, el final de la temporada Navideña fue marcada 40 días después de Navidad, el 2 de febrero el día de la presentación de Jesús en el templo. En nuestra época, pasamos al Tiempo Ordinario después de la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, que celebramos este fin de semana.

El bautismo de Jesús es lo que llamamos una "teofanía", o un momento en que vislumbramos su divinidad. Jesús no fue bautizado porque necesitaba que le quitaran el pecado (el no tiene pecado), sino para hacer que todas las aguas de la tierra fueran apropiadas para el bautismo y para guiarnos por el camino que él quiere que vayamos.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia dice: "El gesto de Jesús [de someterse al bautismo] es una manifestación de despojo así mismo. El Espíritu que había flotado sobre las aguas de la primera creación, descendió entonces sobre el Cristo como preludio de la nueva creación, y el Padre reveló a Jesús como "su Hijo amado" (CCC 1224).

La mayoría de nosotros no recordamos nuestro bautismo y, en consecuencia, nos perdemos un poco de su poder transformador. Me encanta hablar con personas fueron bautizadas en su adolescencia o más grandes aún. Ellos hablan con gran alegría (y lágrimas) de ese momento. La experiencia es similar a la que Jesús tuvo en la que "escuchaba" la voz del Padre diciéndoles hermosas palabras de amor.

Si nunca has sido bautizado, nos encantaría caminar con tigo para recibir este regalo. Si estas bautizado, agradécele a tus padres y padrinos, incluso si han muerto, pues ellos te dieron el regalo más importante convirtiéndote en un hijo o hija de Dios.
